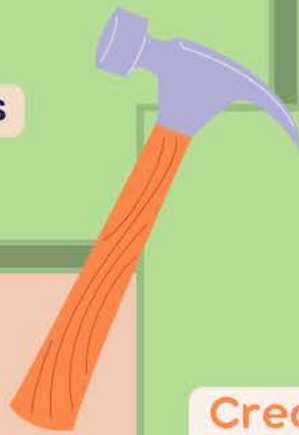

- 1) Green Construction Intern: Get involved in the design and construction of a sustainable home that will be entered into the Orange County Sustainability Decathlon. Minimum of two one-week trips, 40 hours each trip (total=80 hrs. at \$16/hr.) planned over winter, spring, and/or summer breaks and during the two weeks of the Orange County competition. Learned skills include:
 - a. Sustainable house design and construction
 - b. Greenhouse design and construction
 - c. Water systems
 - d. Power systems
 - e. Sensor systems
 - f. Garden and plant systems
 - g. Lighting
- 2) Communications, Social Media, and Interior Design Intern: Get involved in the design and construction of a sustainable home that will be entered into the Orange County Sustainability Decathlon. Interns will work on creating content for social media and fundraising videos for the project. Minimum of two one-week trips, 40 hours each trip (total=80 hrs. at \$16/hr.) planned over winter, spring, and/or summer breaks and during the two weeks of the Orange County competition.
- 3) Opportunities for Class Credit: Help with specific aspects of UCSC's entry into the Orange County Sustainability Decathlon: Sustainable house design and construction, greenhouse design and construction, water systems, power systems, sensor systems, garden and plant systems, and lighting.
